SPEAKING AND LISTENING

Kindergarten classes will visit the school library on the following days:

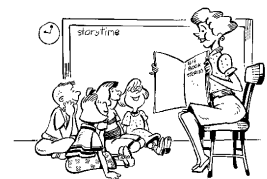
KB and KR: Tuesday
