STAGE 3 MATHEMATICS HELP TIPS

 Skill in solving problems is one of the goals of mathematical study. Ask your child to show you how he or she goes about solving a word problem in math. The steps in the process might include trying to understand the question, finding the pertinent information, deciding what to do, working out the answer, and checking the answer.

Always highlight the key words of the question and try to put the question into a number sentence.

- Provide questions to your child about real life situations by getting your child to help you in the kitchen. Cooking allows students to calculate different measurement problems and apply to real situations. By students just measuring 250ml of milk they are learning about capacity without even knowing it. This could also lead to measuring and calculating mass as well.
- The upcoming holidays offer an extensive amount of opportunities to use mathematical language with your child. Working out total amounts when shopping, subtracting money, working out percentages on sale items are just to name a few.

Maths should be fun and hands on. The more time you spend with your child doing activities in which they apply mathematical skills the better mathematicians they will become.


